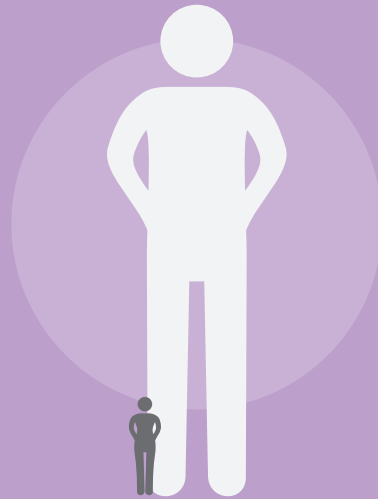
Women in non-executives roles in the largest companies in the EU-28
